

Draft Wireless Message from the Passport Control
Officer at The Hague to the German Generals.

Message containing views of His Majesty's Government was sent from London on November 6th and should have been delivered verbally to your representatives by ours. It is possible that this was done, but in the circumstances we cannot be sure.

Gist of message was that there must be a restoration of confidence which could only be achieved by a change both of the existing German régime and of the spirit behind it. If this were effected then we would be prepared to talk, but only after consultation with the French. In any case we do not contemplate a Europe in which Germany will not play her due part as a great and respected nation.

Consequently the next move is with you.
